APMP for PRINCE2® Practitioners

Course Objective

APMP is a knowledge based qualification. Successful candidates go on to use the knowledge gained to work more effectively on both large and small projects. Delegates study 37 of the 52 knowledge areas covered by the APM Body of Knowledge.

Course Details

This course takes place over 5 days, including the optional examination. Delegates should be aware that evening preparation and consolidation will be required to pass the exam. Joining instructions are sent out approximately 2 to 3 weeks before the course. During the 5 days, there will be a combination of formal presentations, group and individual exercise enabling delegates to gain a complete and practical understanding of the following topics.

- Project management in context
- Planning and strategy
- Executing the strategy
- Techniques
- Business and commercial
- Organisation and governance
- People and profession

Delegate Profile

Delegates will be practising Project Managers who are also current PRINCE2 Registered Practitioners. They will wish to demonstrate that they have acquired knowledge or experience beyond PRINCE2. The APM Introductory Certificate is not a pre-requisite.
